



# Herriman High School Reopening Plan

Welcome back to school! We are excited for the energy and enthusiasm your students bring to our building and want to assure you that faculty and staff have prepared for their return. Teachers have worked all summer developing curriculum to engage students both in the classroom and online if that becomes necessary. Our custodial staff has worked nonstop to ensure protective measures are in place to reduce the risk of COVID-19 transmission. All state and district guidelines will be followed. ## **Please note:**

- All faculty and staff will be reminded, "if you feel sick, stay home."
- No-touch thermometers will be available for temperature checks if needed.
- Face masks will be worn by all until further notice.
- Personal protective equipment will be used by staff based on assignment.
- Assemblies and other large gatherings will be virtual or postponed.
- High traffic areas have been identified and signs have been placed to direct traffic.

## **Face Coverings**

All students will be required to wear a face mask. Exceptions are outlined in the appendix of the [Jordan School District's plan](#). Jordan School District recognizes that some students may have a medical condition, mental health condition, or disability that prevents wearing a face covering. Friday Bell Schedule

### Friday Lunch Schedule

Lunch is available from 12:00-12:40 for all students, including online students. Online students must pick up a grab-n-go lunch and leave the school premises. Breakfast and lunch can be served at the same time on Friday. Both options will be offered to every student and those not on free lunch will get charged for both meals.

### Before Coming to School

Parents, please check your student(s) for any CoVid-19 symptoms including:

- cough
- fever 100.4 or greater
- shortness of breath or trouble breathing
- sore throat
- muscle aches and pain
- new loss of taste or smell
- chills
- fatigue
- headache
- nausea or vomiting
- diarrhea

If you do not have a thermometer, check your children's skin to see if it feels warm or is red, or ask if they have chills.

If your children feel sick or have any of these symptoms, please keep them home. Please notify the school at 801-567-8550 if your student is involved in a positive COVID-19 test result (privacy will be respected and anonymity maintained when at all possible).

### [COVID Isolation, Quarantine, and Return to Work/School Guidelines](#)

Students will not be penalized in their grades or attendance for staying home when ill or in quarantine. Teachers have worked diligently to provide online content so students don't get behind.

Please note:

- Overnight travel and field trips have been canceled through December 2020 (to be re-evaluated in November.)
- Large group performances will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis in consultation with the Salt Lake County Health Department and District Administration.
- Assemblies are discouraged but can be held virtually or in person if proper social distancing can be maintained.
- Dances have been canceled through December 2020.
- UHSAA events allow for limited spectators.

### Checking-in / Checking-out

Students who arrive after 7:30 must check in at the Attendance Office. Students will scan their Student IDs to check-in and then go to class. Students who are checking-out must do so through the Attendance Office using the same protocol. Parents are required to call the Attendance Office to excuse absences for any reason.

### In our Classrooms

- Desks will be spaced as far apart as possible and will face in one direction.
- Reduced sharing of items and sanitizing between users.
- Enhanced cleaning and disinfecting procedures on all surfaces.
- Hand sanitizer will be provided in each room.
- Frequent hand washing.
- Teachers provided plexiglass and face masks.
- Outdoor teaching is encouraged when possible.
- Drinking fountains are for refilling water bottles only.

### Gym and Dance Studios

- Gym equipment will be sanitized on a regular basis.
- Activities/classes generally held in the gym will be held outside weather permitting.
- Weight rooms and exercise equipment will be disinfected regularly.

### Hallways

- Flow patterns have been designated and signs posted.
- Doors have been specified ENTRANCE and EXIT
- Regular cleaning and disinfecting of all touchpoint areas.
- Students will be encouraged to bring labelled, refillable water bottles.
- Drinking fountains are for refilling water bottles only.

### Cafeteria

- Flow patterns have been designated and signs posted.
- Cafeteria tables will be spaced apart and plexiglass installed to allow students to sit on each side of the table.
- Tables will be cleaned and disinfected between each lunch the cafeteria.
- Students will receive their meal or take their home lunch and sit down to eat at the table and are encouraged to eat outside, weather permitting.
- Hand sanitizer will be available at each entrance and exit.
- Students will use their school ID to be scanned for touchless recording of purchased meals.
- Cafeteria breakfasts and lunches will be provided in grab and go disposable containers.

We will not have our fresh fruit and vegetable bar. Vegetables and fruits will be furnished in the grab and go containers. Parents can apply for free or reduced lunch prices by going to the [Jordan District Nutrition Website](#) for directions. [Breakfast and lunch menus](#) are available including nutrition information.

\*ONLINE STUDENTS can pick up GRAB and GO breakfast and/or lunches M-Th from 7:00 - 7:30am (Regular charges apply.) On Fridays, online students can pick up their meals (regular charges apply) from 12:00-12:30. No bus service is available for these options.

### Restrooms

- Signs have been placed in all restrooms by each sink with proper hand washing protocols.
- Students must wear face coverings when using the restroom.
- Restrooms will be disinfected throughout the day & deep cleaned at the end of each day.
- A limited number of students will be allowed in the restroom at the same time.

### Media Center

- One classroom is allowed in the library at a time to check out textbooks and library books.
- Books will be out of circulation for 3 days after each use.

### Chromebook Check-out

Students who opted for online classes and need a Chromebook or graphing calculator can check one out from the library after they fill out the user agreement. All Chromebooks must be returned, and if any are returned damaged, a fine will be assessed and posted to the student's Skyward account.

### Quarantine Room

A quarantine room is located near the Attendance Office for students whose temperature is above 100.4, or feel ill, and are waiting for a ride home. We ask that parents come as quickly as possible when notified that a child needs to come home. Symptomatic individuals cannot return to school unless their symptoms are not due to a communicable disease as confirmed by a medical provider. This quarantine space will be deeply cleaned before the sick student is isolated and after the sick student leaves for home.

### Special Education , 504s and Health Care Plans

Staff will review all current Individual Healthcare Plans, 504 Accommodation Plans, and Individualized Education Plans (IEP) for accommodating students with special healthcare needs and update their care plans as needed. Accommodations using PPE and social distancing measures will be made when working with students who are unable to wear face coverings.

### Volunteers

We love having volunteers in our building and appreciate the involvement of parents. During this unique time, we need to limit the number of visitors and volunteers; therefore, volunteers or visitors will be allowed on a limited basis with approval by an administrator. There are many ways you can still volunteer. Communicate with the PTSA president to help with needs that can be met without being here at school. We look forward to the time when we can welcome all of our volunteers back to the building.
